

CARPENTERS TOOL LIST

The following is a list of the minimum tools that every Carpenter will have with him when reporting to work for any contractor.

- (1) Tool Box (not a five gallon bucket)
- (1) Nail Apron or Tool Pouch (side pouches are easier on the back)
- (1) Framing Square with Rafter Tables
- (1) 24 inch or 30 inch Level (Spirit)
- (1) Torpedo Level
- (1) Combination Square or Swanson Speed Square
- (1) Claw hammer – 20 ounce minimum
- (1) Pry Bar – Crowbar
- (1) Cats Claw (nail puller)
- (1) Plumb Bob – 8 ounce – 16 ounce
- (1) 8 Point Handsaw
- (1) Chalk box with Chalk
- (1) Tape Measure (25 foot or 30 foot)
- (1) 100 Foot Tape Measure
- (1) Adjustable Wrench – 12 inch
- (1 set) Wood Chisels
- (1 set) Assorted Screw Drivers (slotted and Phillips)
- (1 pair) Pliers (offset lineman)
- (1 par) Tin Snips
- (1) Utility Knife with Blades
- (1) Hacksaw
- (1) Keyhole Saw
- (1) Coping Saw with Extra Blades
- (1) Dryline string – 100 foot
- (1) Small Block Plane
- (1) Nail Sets
- (1) Compass (divider)
- (1) Flat Metal File – 10 inch
- (1) Wood Rasp

Appropriate work boots and clothing, some jobs may require steel-toed work boots.
